Year 1 Phonics Meetings Reminder

Just a quick reminder to all Year 1 parents to attend the phonics meetings that are taking place next week.

My Maths - Year 1

We have found that a number of children are still not regularly accessing their reading eggs programme. We advise that children log in at least 3 times a week as it will help them with a range of Literacy skills. Children

should carry out the tasks independently as it is a personalised programme. Please only provide your child with support on how to use the computer (if needed).
