They discovered how scientists search for signs of life on Mars, exploring what conditions make a planet habitable and the role of rovers in collecting evidence. The session sparked curiosity about the possibility of microbial life and future missions to the Red Planet. It was an exciting opportunity to learn from experts about space exploration and the advancements helping us understand Mars better.
