Homework:

Homework at Edison Primary is given out to pupils on a Friday and must be returned to school on the following Wednesday.

The homework comprises of the following:

Talk homework - Based on British Values, Picture news or Science

English - to comprise of one English related activity: SPaG, Comprehension or Writing

Reading Eggs - All pupils are provided with a reading Eggs account and required to complete two activities per week.

Maths - Could have a "My Maths" activity, Key skills practice or a worksheet. Reception maths homework is usually more practical.
