

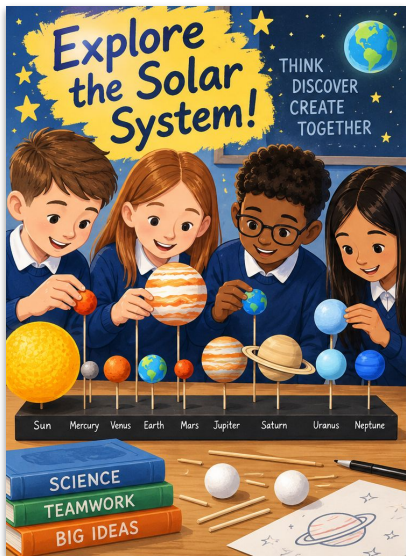

IGNITING YOUNG MINDS, FOR A BRIGHTER TOMORROW

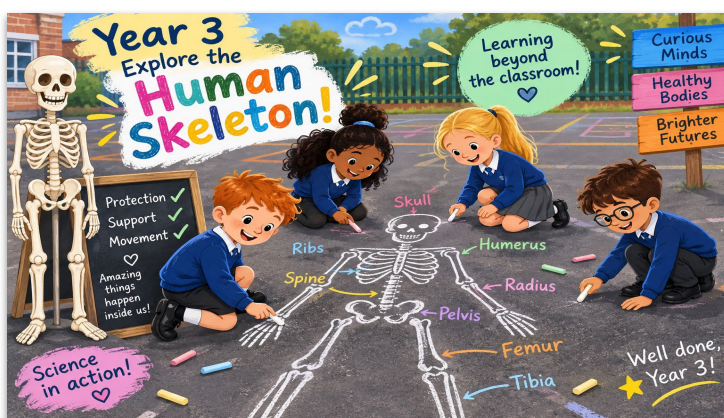

Year 5 Explore the Solar System! Year 5 did a fantastic job creating their own models of the Solar System! As part of their Science learning, pupils explored the order of the planets from the Sun, their relative sizes and their distances from the Sun. Working collaboratively, the children carefully considered which polystyrene balls best represented the different sizes of the planets and which wooden sticks could represent their relative distances from the Sun. A brilliant hands-on activity that encouraged teamwork, scientific thinking and problem-solving. Well done, Year 5.

Year 3 Explore the Human Skeleton Year 3 have done a fantastic job learning about the bones in the human body! Pupils learnt the names of key bones and explored how our skeleton helps with protection, support and movement. They then took their learning outdoors, working together in the playground to draw life-sized human skeletons with chalk and label the different bones. It was a fun and creative way for the children to apply their scientific knowledge and bring their learning to life. Well done, Year 3.

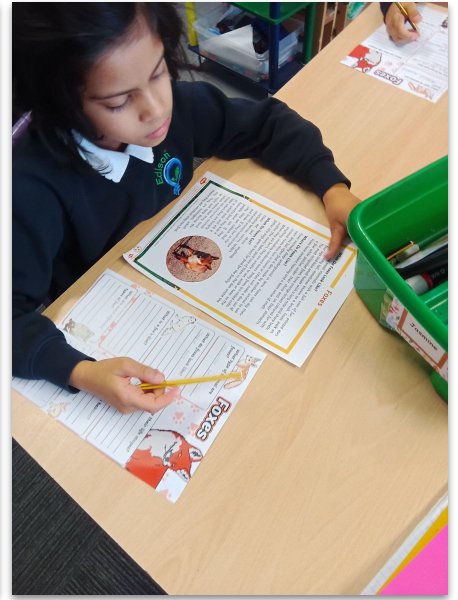




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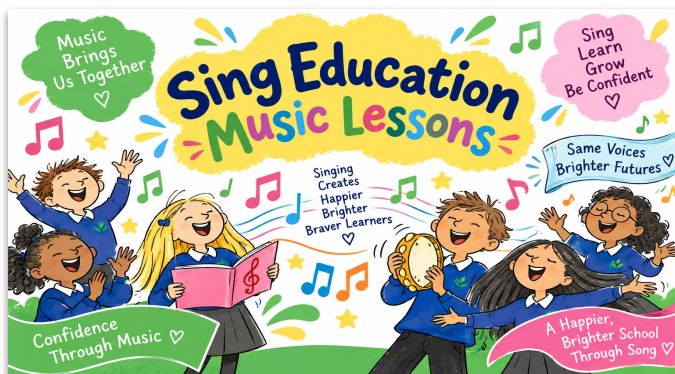
IGNITING YOUNG MINDS, FOR A BRIGHTER TOMORROW
