ENRICHMENT AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS SPRING KEY INFORMATION 2026



By booking an after-school club, parents commit to paying for the club for the whole term irrespective of whether your child attends all sessions. Where some clubs have reached maximum capacity, we will operate a waiting list for oversubscribed clubs.

Please email: info@edisonprimary.org if you would like your child to be added to a waiting list.

Behaviour:

We have high expectations of our pupils during the school day and these expectations remain the same during our school clubs. If your child's behaviour impacts other children attending the club, club leaders will inform parents.

Club leaders reserve the right to discontinue a child's attendance if a child's behaviour shows no improvement. There will be no refunds for these circumstances.

Late Collection:

Club leaders will monitor late collection of pupils after their clubs finish. Regular and frequent late collections from clubs will incur additional charges and risks your child's place in their after school club.

If a parent arrives at school after 5:15pm, a charge of £5 will be added to their ParentPay account.

If a parent arrives at school after 5:30pm a charge of £10 will be added to their ParentPay account.

Disclosure of Information:

To ensure that our club leaders are able to meet the needs of the children in their care, we ask that you consent for us to provide relevant information about your child to the club leader. We ask that that you get in touch with school if you do not consent to this.
